Fifteen visual and performative artists from France, Belgium, Slovenia, the Netherlands, Morocco, Germany, Denmark, China, the USA, Turkey and Bulgaria will meet and work together for two weeks in Sofia to present on October 8 a seven-hour happening, containing [site specific](#) installations, theater and vocal performances, [multi-sensory sound environment](#), projections, contemporary dance, music, radio and immersive art.

In search of the collective imagination, on October 8, the underground spaces of the Cultural Institute "Krasno Selo" will become a [stage for visual art](#), performance and sound art within the framework of The Image Generator event .

The Image Generator is a site specific happening - an initiative of a group of artists and organizations from Antwerp, Belgium, which takes place for the seventh year in a row. The event is a meeting of artists from all over the world who explore the potential of interaction between [different means](#) of expression in direct exchange with audiences and spaces and in

search of new creative perspectives for the human imagination through continuous dialogue and change.

The creative exchange platform The Image Generator will be presented in Sofia on October 8 from 15:00 to 22:00 at the Krasno Selo Cultural Institute, which is opening its unique underground spaces for the first time, positioning them as a new center for contemporary art in the Sofia cultural scene. landscape.

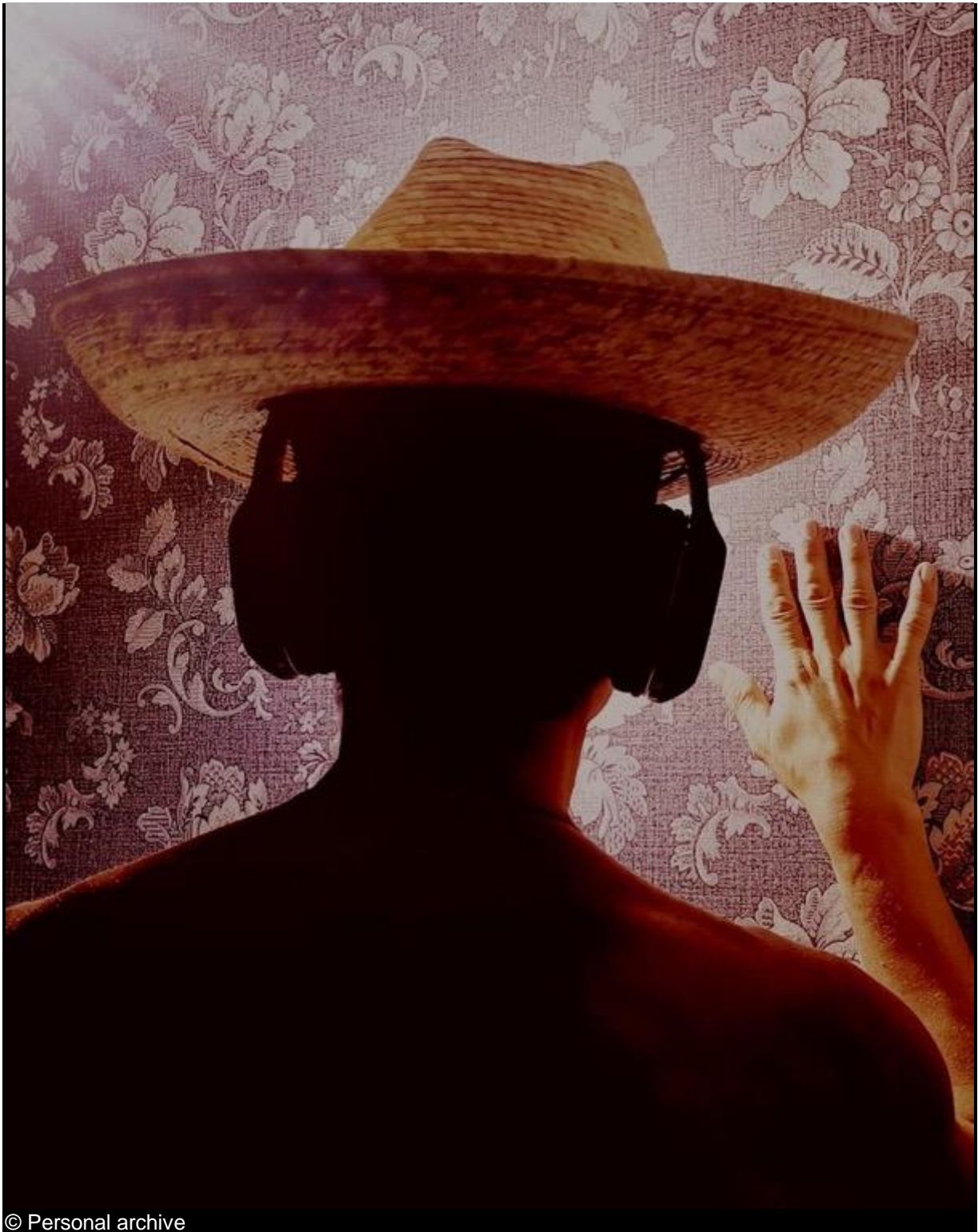
Christian Bakalov - Free DJ TIG set

Yi Zang - Walls Have Ears

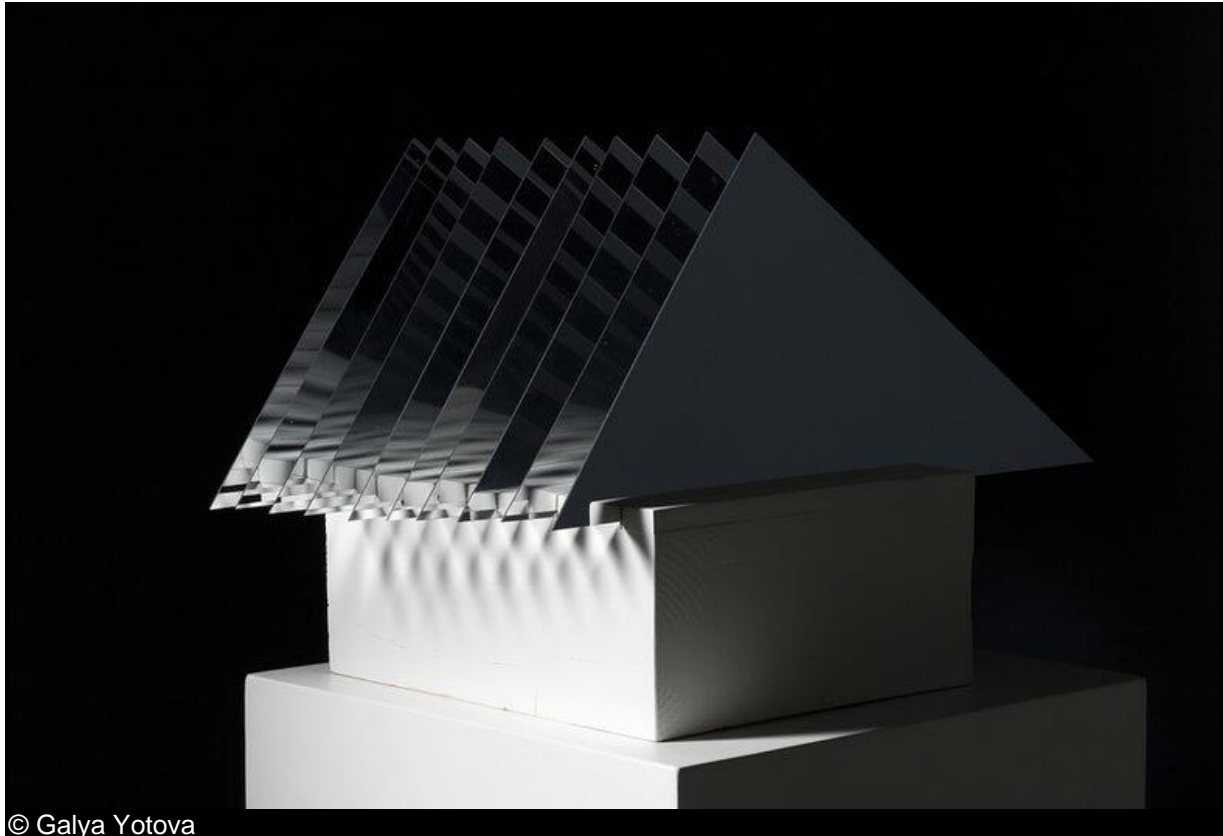
Site specific, an architectural installation exploring how personal spaces flow into their surroundings.
